It has been 3 years since a father was murdered during a home invasion; family wants justice...now

January 18, 2019 Detroit, MI Darrin Wyatt was murdered on Monday, January 18, 2016 at 3:21 a.m. The incident took place in the 5000 block of Vancourt Avenue near West Warren Avenue on Detroit's west side.

Darrin and his family were home asleep in their upstairs bedrooms when they heard the sound of glass breaking downstairs. 911 were called as Darrin went to see where the sound was coming from. As he reached the top of the stairs, he was met by gunfire. The unknown suspect may have fled in a dark colored mid-sized vehicle.

Darrin graduated from Western International High School where he played on the football team. He continued his education at Michigan State University and studied Business Mgmt. and Carpentry. Darrin was employed at Hollingsworth Logistics Management of Detroit, and was in the works to open his own business to be called D's Simple Maintenance. He is the father of three children: Cadiance, Cuylie, and Darrin, Jr. Darrin Wyatt was only 24 years old.

Crime Stoppers of Michigan is offering a cash reward of up to \$2,500 for information that leads the arrest for the murder of Darrin Wyatt. If the tip that leads to her location is received by midnight of today's press conference - \$1,000 will be added to the reward - raising the total to \$3,500.

Since 2013, Crime Stoppers has received more than 24,000 anonymous tips from the public and has awarded more than \$300,000 in cash rewards to anonymous tipsters.
