A father of four gunned down and his family I spleading for answers

January 10, 2019 Detroit, MI. Gary Williams, 37, was shot and killed on Saturday March 31, 2018, at 2:16 a.m. The incident happened in area of Michigan Ave and Lawndale St. on Detroit's southwest side.

According to family, Gary has been a resident of the state of Arizona for the past 6 years. While in town Gary received a call from an unknown caller to attend a birthday celebration of a mutual friend. Gary arrived at approximately 12:30 a.m. Gary left the birthday celebration headed to his vehicle at about 2 a.m. Once he was inside his Grey, 2015 Dodge Caravan, a black SUV pulled up next to him, fired shots into his van, killing him. A call was placed to Detroit Police at approximately 2:15 in response to the shooting.

Gary attended Northern High School in Highland Park, MI. He is the father of 4 children. Gary started a record label in 2012 known as M.T. B. Entertainment. His main focus was his family, his business and travelling.
