## **Information needed in homicide of Sarah Billings in Waterford**

**February 8, 2019 Waterford, MI.** Sarah Billings was killed on Friday, August 31, 2018 on Meigs Avenue in Waterford. At 7:16 p.m. the police department received a call about a female being thrown from a black car that left the area. Sarah Billings was this female who later died from the injuries. The investigation led to an address in White Lake with a black Saturn and the driver committed suicide. It is believed there was a second white male in the Saturn at the time of the death and it may have been involved in a robbery. If you have any information on this incident, please submit a tip to Crime Stoppers.

Crime Stoppers of Michigan is offering a cash reward of up to \$2,500 for information that leads to an arrest for the murder of Sarah Billings. All rewards are paid anonymously.

In the last six years, Crime Stoppers has received more than 33,000 anonymous tips from the public and has awarded more than \$530,000 in cash rewards to anonymous tipsters.
