Crime Stoppers offering cash reward in an armed robbery of an ATM Technician in Roseville

February 4, 2019 Roseville, MI. The suspect pictured below in the surveillance photos is wanted for an armed robbery of an ATM technician on Sunday, January 27, 2019 in Roseville. The robbery took place at the Bank of America located at 20695 E. 12 Mile Road near Little Mack. The suspect fled the location in a white Dodge with a dealer plate and damage on the driver side brake light.

The suspect broke the ATM with a hammer and then waited for the technician to arrive. Once the technician arrived, the suspect held a gun to the tech and demanded money to be removed from the ATM safe. The suspect fled with the ATM drop-boxes containing \$88,000.

Crime Stoppers of Michigan is offering a cash reward of up to \$1,000 for information that leads to an arrest of the suspect involved in the robbery. All rewards are paid anonymously.

In the last six years, Crime Stoppers has received more than 33,000 anonymous tips from the public and has awarded more than \$530,000 in cash rewards to anonymous tipsters.
